



Charging Policy

Brambly House Charging Policy for Funded Entitlements

At Brambly House Montessori Nursery School, we welcome the government's funded early education entitlements and are committed to transparency in how these are delivered.

Funded Hours

We offer government-funded early education hours between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm, term time only (38 weeks per year). These hours are available free of charge for eligible children. Families may choose to extend their child's day or attend outside term time for an additional charge.

Charges for Additional Services

Government funding does not cover meals, snacks, consumables (such as nappies, wipes, sun cream), or enrichment activities. To maintain high-quality provision and consistency, we apply charges for:

- Meals and snacks (fresh, balanced menus prepared daily)
- Consumables (nappies, wipes, sun cream, craft materials)
- Enrichment activities (e.g., music, Forestry)

Our full fee structure, including funded and non-funded elements, is published on our website.

Invoices

Invoices are clearly separated:

- Funded entitlement hours
- Additional hours
- Food and consumables
- Optional activities

Admissions Policy

We offer a limited number of funded-only places each term. These places are allocated in line with our admissions policy and subject to availability. Families may also choose to extend their child's hours or attend outside term time for an additional charge.



Why we do not offer alternatives

Due to the nature of our Montessori approach and safeguarding requirements, we cannot accommodate packed lunches or alternative arrangements. This ensures all children receive consistent care, nutrition, and safety standards.
